Four men from Rajasthan as SUV falls into ditch in MP's Sheopur. In a tragic accident, four men from Rajasthan lost their lives in Sheopur district, Madhya Pradesh, after their vehicle swerved to avoid a cow and crashed into a tree. The incident occurred around 11:30 p.m. on Sunday in the Kali Talai area amid heavy rain-fall, when the driver of a sports utility vehicle (SUV) attempted to save a cow sitting on the road. The sudden manoeuvre caused the vehicle to veer off the road, plunge into a roadside ditch, and collide with a tree. All four occupants of the vehicle died on the spot, including three members of the same family. The deceased have been identified as Harihar Yadav (60), his son Mukesh Yadav (28), and their relative Vijendra Jat (23). The fourth victim was Haba Singh Gurjar. According to police, the cow also died in the accident. The vehicle was severely damaged, and the impact was fatal for all passengers, a police official said. AGENCIES

# India's Bullet Train dream picks up speed

First undersea tunnel section completed in Mumbai-Ahmedabad corridor

The Bullet Train Project has achieved a major milestone with the opening of the first section of the 21-km undersea tunnel between BKC and Thane.

"The bullet train project recently achieved a major milestone by completing 310 km of viaduct construction. Track laying, construction of overhead electrical wires, stations, and bridges is going on at a rapid pace," the Ministry of Railways said on Monday.

In Maharashtra, the progress on procurement of systems for operations and control is also going on well.

The Japanese Shinkansen is currently running E5 trains. Next generation trains are



E10. In the spirit of strategic partnership between Japan and India, the Japanese government has agreed to introduce E10 Shinkansen trains in the Mumbai-Ahmedabad Bullet train project. It is noteworthy that E10 will be introduced simultaneously in India and Japan.

The entire 508 km corridor is being developed with Japanese Shinkansen technology. It will set new benchmarks for speed, safety, and reliability. This reflects the

deep strategic and technological cooperation between India and Japan.

Civil works are progressing at a rapid pace across the alignment. 310 km viaduct is complete and four are in the advanced stages of construction. Of the 12 stations, five are completed while three more are reaching completion stage. The station at BKC is an engineering marvel. It will be located 32.5 metres below ground

The construction work in Maharashtra has also picked up pace. In parallel, the progress on procurement of systems for operations and control is also going on well.

and the foundation is designed to support the construction of a 95 metres high building above ground.

The success of the Mumbai-Ahmedabad High-Speed Rail (MAHSR) project is laying the foundation for future bullet train corridors in India. Future corridors are also under active consideration.

This remarkable pace of development showcases India's capability to execute world-class infrastructure using cutting-edge global technology, with Japan playing a pivotal role as a trusted partner in this transformative journey.

## Home Minister responsible for foreign nationals in Bihar: RJD to Centre

The Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) launched a scathing attack at the Central government on Monday, following the Election Commission of India's (ECI) disclosures that a significant number of individuals from Nepal, Bangladesh, and Myanmar were found during the ongoing Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls in Bihar.

RJD MP Manoj Jha held the Union Home Minister directly responsible for the alleged presence of foreign nationals in the state, demanding accountability and even calling for resignations.

Manoj Jha, speaking to IANS said: "Nothing can be more unfortunate than this. The ECI is a constitutional body we have long placed our faith in — built on the foundations laid by pioneers like Sukumar Sen (Former Chief Election Commissioner of India). But today, under the pretext of 'intensive revision', anarchy is being pro-



jected. Field reporters and journalists covering this are facing direct and indirect threats. What is happening to our democracy?"

Jha further questioned the credibility of the electoral verification process, pointing out that even the Prime Minister was elected based on the same voter rolls now under scrutiny.

"If even a single Bangladeshi is found on the electoral rolls, then who failed to prevent this? It's not a failure of the local administration — this is a national issue. The Union Home Minister is responsible. He should

resign and accept that his ministry has failed. It's an open and shut case," Jha told IANS.

He also hit out at BJP over latter's claim that the RJD and Congress were opposing the Special Intensive Revision.

"Has the BJP seen the entire electoral roll? Is the ECI now functioning as their alliance partner?" Jha asked. "The ECI is meant to be the watchdog of our democracy — not a 'lapdog' of the ruling party. If foreigners are indeed staying in Bihar, then hold the Home Minister and the Prime Minister accountable," he said.

## Tarlok Singh Chauhan appointed Chief Justice of Jharkhand High Court

Justice Tarlok Singh Chauhan, currently serving as a Judge of Himachal Pradesh High Court, has been appointed as the Chief Justice of Jharkhand High Court.

The appointment was made by the President of India in consultation with the Chief Justice of India, as part of a wider reshuffle involving elevation and transfer of Chief Justices across several High Courts.

Meanwhile, Justice M.S. Ramachandra Rao, who has been serving as the Chief Justice of Jharkhand High Court, has been transferred to Tripura High Court as its Chief Justice.

Justice Chauhan brings with him long judicial experience from the Himachal Pradesh High Court. His appointment comes at a time when several key matters related to governance, corruption, and socio-economic rights are pending before the Jharkhand High Court.

The changes are part of a broader realignment aimed at ensuring administrative efficiency and uniformity across the higher judiciary.

MP: Harda tensions ease as curbs lifted, Karni Sena to stick to peaceful protest

In Harda, Madhya Pradesh, the dust appears to be settling after a weekend of unrest sparked by a confrontation between Karni Sena activists and police. The town, which witnessed widespread protests and heavy security deployment, is gradually returning to normalcy.

District Collector Aditya Singh has lifted 163 prohibitory orders and authorised the release of those arrested during the 'chakka jam' demonstration. Despite the eases, local authorities remain cautious, noting that tensions could resurface as community leaders and supporters continue to express dissent. The atmosphere, while calmer, remains under close watch.

The unrest began after Ashish Rajput, a Karni Sena activist, filed a complaint alleging a fraud of Rs 18 lakh in a diamond deal involving three individuals. AGENCIES

## MP CM Yadav's meeting in UAE to strengthen cooperation under CEPA

Madhya Pradesh Chief Minister Mohan Yadav on Monday held in-depth discussions with the UAE's Minister of State for Foreign Trade, Dr. Thani bin Ahmed Al Zeyoudi, to expand economic and industrial cooperation under the India-UAE Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement (CEPA), during his ongoing official visit to Dubai.

Dr. Yadav stated that CEPA provides a strong economic foundation and that Madhya Pradesh is ready to fully leverage this partnership to open new avenues for investment, trade, and technological collaboration. The Chief Minister highlighted that Madhya Pradesh, with its strategic geographic location, advanced infrastructure, and progressive industrial policy

support, has emerged as a rising investment destination in logistics, manufacturing, and food processing. He welcomed UAE investment in sectors such as automobiles, pharmaceuticals, textiles, defense manufacturing, and smart manufacturing.

CM Yadav noted that Madhya Pradesh is a leading producer of soybeans, pulses, and organic products in India. He expressed interest in working jointly with the UAE in food processing and agricultural technology to strengthen supply chains between India and the Gulf region.

The Chief Minister invited the UAE's expertise in areas like solar energy, smart automation, embedded electronics, and Industry 4.0. He emphasised that rapidly developing renewable energy projects in Madhya Pradesh present attractive

investment opportunities for UAE investors.

Dr. Yadav informed that fully developed industrial clusters in Madhya Pradesh are ready to welcome UAE investment. These include PM MITRA Park (Textiles) in Dhar, Plastic Parks in Tamot and Bilaua, Medical Device Park in Ujjain, Auto Cluster in Pithampur, Electronics Cluster in Bhopal, and Pharma Cluster in Dewas. The CM assured that all clusters are backed by the state's 'Industry Mitra' policy that ensures facilitation and infrastructure support.

CM Dr. Yadav shared that the Global Skills Partnership being developed with Singapore, in collaboration with Singapur, will provide a trained workforce in fields like logistics, hospitality, healthcare, and mechatronics, aligned to the UAE's industry requirements.

## Rajasthan Anti Conversion Bill needs amendments to make it effective and stringent, says VHP prez Alok

The Vishwa Hindu Parishad (VHP) has held that the Anti Conversion Bill introduced in the Rajasthan assembly in February during the budget session earlier this year, is not effective enough, and suggested some amendments in the bill.

Talking to mediapersons here on Monday, VHP President Alok Kumar said: "I have been here for past five days and during the sojourn here, I met five prominent saints with whom talks revolved on issues like forced conversions, 'Ghar Vapsi', cow protection and family values. Saints were worried about attempts made for conversions."

The VHP chief stressed upon the passage of a stringent anti-conversion law in



Rajasthan, saying, "I met state Chief Minister on the first day of current visit and conveyed to him our demand of stringent and effective law."

"I conveyed to the CM that the bill introduced in the assembly during last session has certain provisions that are likely to make the law ineffective. For instance, the bill has a provision that anti-conversion law can be lodged only by a family

member, however, what will happen if the entire family has converted into Christianity," Kumar said.

Hence, the Bill requires some amendments, he said, adding: "We (VHP) have suggested some amendments to the bill. Chief Minister and I believe that VHP and the state government are on the same page so far amendments are concerned."

He hoped that a stringent and effective law would be legislated by the state assembly in the next session.

Kumar said that rate of population growth in the country has declined from 2.1 Total Fertility Rate (TFR) to 1.9 TFR and contrary to this, the corresponding data pertaining to Muslims is 0.9 per cent higher than Hindus. Rajasthan Health Minister Kapil Khandelwal introduced the bill in the state

assembly here on 3 February 2025 for legislating the anti-conversion law, with the aim to prohibit unlawful and forced religious conversions.

Parliamentary Affairs Minister Joga Ram Patel had claimed in February 2025 that the bill will offer effective deterrence against conversions by way of fear, promise decors or by deceitfully luring for marriage with pressure for conversion. This new version will have provision of stringent punishment with rigorous jail terms, Patel has said.

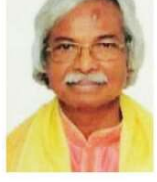
Some organisations in such conversations, and the law will offer deterrence to such conversions. The State Cabinet had approved two months back the draft bill of 'The Rajasthan Prohibition of Unlawful Conversion of Religion Act' to such conversions against so called 'love jihad'.

## JPP chief Besra seeks extension of Jharkhand Movement Panel till 2029

Jharkhand People's Party (JPP) president Surya Singh Besra on Monday demanded that the tenure of the Jharkhand State Movement Recognition Committee be extended till 2029 to ensure due recognition and benefits for all statehood movement activists.

He pointed out that though the commission was constituted in 2012, it ceased functioning after 13 July. "Out of nearly 70,000 applications submitted so far, only 20,000 have been verified, and around 5,000 recognised activists are receiving monthly pensions of 4,500 or 7,000," he said.



Calling the process incomplete, Besra said over 50,000 applications are still pending. He demanded an amendment to the state home department's resolution to remove the mandatory condition of imprisonment for

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recognition, arguing that all participants in the Jharkhand statehood movement deserve to be treated at par with freedom fighters.

He further demanded 30,000 as monthly pension for all recognised activists, along with free education, healthcare, transport passes for dependents, and a government job guarantee for

one family member of each activist.

Criticising the Jharkhand Mukti Morcha (JMM) for despite to honour the movement despite ruling the state for the longest period, Besra said: "The government has committed grave injustice to the activists of Jharkhand. The activists will never forgive this betrayal."

## Breaking stereotypes: Tribal girls steer into Jharkhand's male-dominated auto industry

In a first-of-its-kind initiative in Jharkhand, Tata Motors has successfully trained and certified an all-girls batch of tribal youth in motor mechanics under its Kaushalya Programme. The development was announced on the occasion of World Youth Skills Day.

The batch, comprising 13 girls from gram panchayats in Chandil, Potka, and Jamshepur, completed a 50-day classroom training module focused on commercial vehicle systems. The course was followed by a one-year on-the-job Training (OJT) at authorised service stations and dealerships associated with Tata Motors.

All trainees were selected from underserved tribal communities, many of whom had



previously discontinued formal education. Tata Motors, in collaboration with Vikas Samities—a company-run society—undertook mobilisation efforts through local outreach, family counselling, and community engagement to ensure participation.

The programme provided trainees with residential accommodation, uniforms, safety gear, and a monthly stipend throughout the training period.

opportunities for young women in traditionally male-dominated sectors. He said the company aimed to build a safe and supportive training environment to enable girls from remote communities to access employability pathways previously unavailable to them.

The Kaushalya Programme is part of Tata Motors' broader CSR framework aimed at promoting skill development and sustainable livelihoods in rural and tribal regions. The company stated that the successful completion of this batch demonstrates the viability of gender-inclusive training models in the automotive sector.

According to the company, similar programmes are under consideration for replication in other regions, based on local demand and institutional partnerships.

## SC agreeing to hear Uddhav's poll symbol plea in Aug brings hope to Sena

The Supreme Court agreed on Monday to hear Shiv Sena chief Uddhav Thackeray's plea challenging the Election Commission decision about the party's selection symbol in August.

It may be recalled that the Election Commission had recognised the party led by Maharashtra Deputy CM Eknath Shinde as the official Shiv Sena and allotted the bow and arrow symbol of the undivided Shiv Sena, to the Shinde-led party. The Supreme Court agreeing to hear Uddhav Thackeray's plea in August has brought some hope to the Uddhav Thackeray-led Shiv Sena, which will contest the soon to be announced municipal elections against the BJP-led Mahayuti alliance.

## Jharkhand govt sets Jan 2026 deadline to fully implement e-Office system across the state

The Jharkhand government has set January 2026 as the deadline to implement the e-Office Lite system across all state departments. Chief Secretary Alka Tiwari reviewed the status of the initiative during a meeting with senior officials and technical representatives from RailTel, NIC, and JAPIT on Monday. She directed the Information Technology Department to ensure a complete and error-free rollout within the set timeframe.

During the review, the Chief Secretary instructed that all physical files be scanned and uploaded in PDF format to avoid dependence on hard copies. She said the system should be made secure to pre-



vent cyber-related risks and allow officials to operate the system remotely where required. The agencies responsible for implementation have been asked to prepare a department-wise execution timeline.

The e-Office system is currently operational in four departments: Personnel, Administrative Reforms and Rajbhasha, Finance, and Information Technology and e-Governance, along with Higher Education. Officers in the

departments are being trained, and official email accounts have been created for e-Office use. Remaining departments have been asked to initiate the process.

Officials said that the system will enable access to government files digitally, reducing the need for physical handling and multiple photocopies.
